March 2023 project update

You will notice that Upper Brook Street Car Park is closing from Friday 3rd March 2023 to enable the start of the new St Clements Surgery development. To begin with there will be a small presence on site whilst Archaeological investigative work is being carried out and you will notice machinery on site whilst trenches are dug. These works are due to start on Monday the 6th March 2023.

We anticipate that Archaeological work will take approximately 3 – 5 weeks to complete. There will then be significantly less activity whilst the results of the investigative works are assessed, the results of which will help inform the construction of the building. Following the archaeological works, the main building construction work will commence, and we anticipate completion of the new surgery in Summer 2024.
